

## Footsteps of Faith (4): The Trustworthiness of God's Promises Genesis 15

### I. Abraham was afraid and disappointed (vv.1-3).

A. \_\_\_\_\_ often causes us to project the very worst that can happen (v.1).

B. Just because God is faithful does not mean that He is \_\_\_\_\_  
(vv.2-3; Daniel 3:17-18).

### II. God guarantees the fulfillment of his promises by His specific Word (v.1, 4-6).

A. God's \_\_\_\_\_ must be fulfilled in God's way and in God's time  
(v.1, 4-5).

B. God rewards \_\_\_\_\_ in His promises with  
\_\_\_\_\_ (v.6; Romans 4:23-25).

### III. God guarantees the fulfillment of His promises by His covenant (vv.7-21).

A. God gives us \_\_\_\_\_ reminders of what He has done within us  
and for us (vv.9-17; Jeremiah 34:18-20; Romans 6:4-7; 1 Corinthians 11:23-32).

B. We are not saved by \_\_\_\_\_ promises to God, but by  
\_\_\_\_\_ the promises of God (v.12; Romans 8:29-30).

*Answers: Fear, predictable, will, faith, righteousness, visible, making, believing*
