I. The New Heaven and the New Earth (21:1, 5): A New Order – “I am making everything New!”

II. Citizens of the New Jerusalem (21:2-4; 6-8)

A. The Citizens are God’s People: A “Bride for her husband” (vv 2-4)

**In every age, the Hope of Heaven has been the Encouragement for God’s people,
especially in times of Suffering**

in the Beginning of Genesis, and the Fulfillment of Promise at End of Revelation**
