

Snapshots of Jesus (2): Mighty God Isaiah 9:6

I. Why is Jesus called “Mighty God”?

- A. Jesus is the pattern for our lives.
- B. Jesus is in His essence God.

II. The Battle in the Wilderness (Luke 4:1-13)

- A. The first temptation was a temptation to elevate physical needs above spiritual needs (vv. 2-4; John 4:34).
- B. The second temptation was to become impatient and discontent (vv.5-8; Psalm 2:8; Revelation 11:15).
- C. The third temptation was to doubt God’s wisdom and accept the world’s way of thinking (vv.9-11; Exodus 17:1-7).

III. The Deity of Jesus

- A. Jesus claimed to be God (John 10:30).
- B. Jesus matches the description of God (Isaiah 6:1-5; John 8:46; Isaiah 43:25; Mark 2:1-12).

IV. Conclusion

- A. Jesus shows us that there is a way to overcome temptation and have victory over sin.
- B. Only because Jesus is God is His sacrifice for our sin sufficient.
